

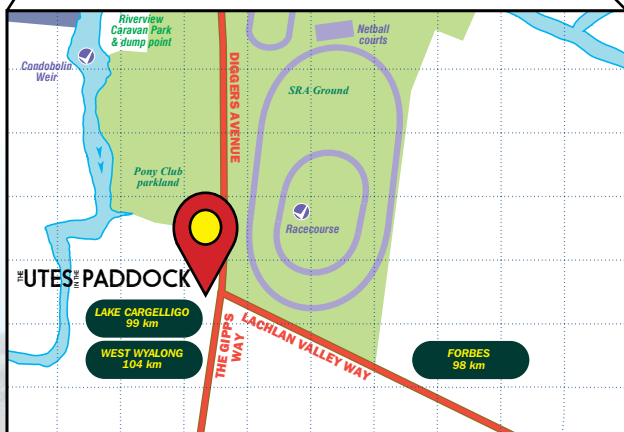
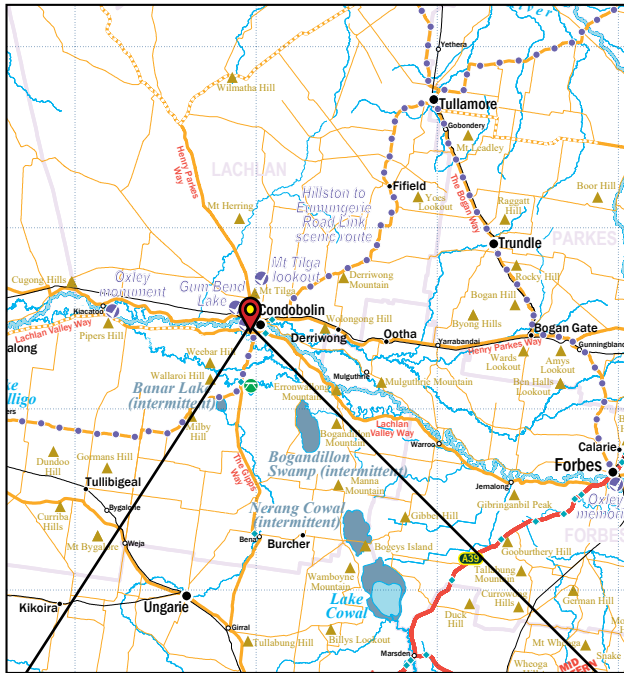
THE UTES IN THE PADDOCK
